



E-Poster FAQs

Q. Why isn't there an e-poster section this year?

A. E-posters will be incorporated into the sections as a 10-minute interactive presentation. In addition to the e-poster, you will prepare a one-page poster summary sheet (template provided) which will provide the basics to the attendees to prepare for the session. The poster will also be displayed through the website and will be included in the proceedings.

Q. How will I present my e-poster?

A. Your e-poster will be displayed on the screen in the section room. You will give a one-minute introduction to your poster and then field questions from the attendees. Attendees may also have viewed the poster on the website, but should have reviewed the summary sheet.

Q. What presentation software should I use to create my e-poster?

A. All e-posters should be created using MS PowerPoint 2010 or later. Recommended fonts are Calibri, Arial, Helvetica, Verdana or Times New Roman with 28 pt. or larger font size.

Q. Are portrait or landscape presentations accepted?

A. Please use landscape mode with a 16x9 page setup size. You may download a template from the SESUG conference website for both your e-poster and your one-page summary sheet.

Q. What is included in the summary sheet?

A. Please include the abstract (or abstract summary if abstract is lengthy), e-poster summary, conclusion or implications and contact information. Please use the template on the conference website.

Q. What is the average number of pages in an e-poster?

A. Presenters will normally have one to five pages of content in their e-posters, including hyperlinked (enlarged) images, rotating graphics, or embedded videos. Videos and other materials need to be embedded as no aspect of the e-poster should be dependent upon the internet.

Q. How large can my e-poster file be?

A. Your file size needs to be limited to 100MB or less.

Q. When is my e-poster due?

A. Your e-poster and summary sheet must be uploaded to the Paper Submission Center **no later than October 5th, 2022.**
